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5. Dirty Boy® SilverBoy



Introducing the Dirty Boy® Silver Boy — a GENOME-exclusive TSM-Ai™ Amplifier that fuses the raw attitude of the nefarious Dirty Boy® Preamp with a custom, expertly tuned 6L6 Push-Pull TSM Poweramp Sim. Designed to bring the very best out of the Preamp's pedal-born character, the Silver Boy adds warmth, body, and sag guitarists crave, delivering a full-spectrum Dirty Boy® experience inside GENOME.

The following parameters are available within the Dirty Boy® SilverBoy Component :

- **GAIN:** Adjusts the input gain for the Dirty Boy® SilverBoy affecting the summative volume and subsequent drive produced by the TSM-Ai Amplifier
- **BASS:** Use this control to attenuate or boost the pre-gain-stage Bass frequency content of the TSM-Ai Amplifier's processed signal
- **VARIAC:** Use this control to alter the voltage feeding the Dirty Boy® SilverBoy amp component; by default, the VARIAC parameter set to its maximum value—reducing the parameter lowers the voltage, resulting in increased break-up
- **MIDDLE:** Use this control to attenuate or boost the post-gain-stage Mid-Range frequency content of the TSM-Ai Amplifier's processed signal
- **VOLUME:** Sets the global volume of the Dirty Boy® SilverBoy's custom Poweramp; increased values drive the Poweramp resulting in increased distortion, harmonics & compression

- **TREBLE:** Use this control to attenuate or boost the pre-gain-stage Treble frequency content of the TSM-Ai Amplifier's processed signal
- **POWER ON/OFF (Switch):** Sets whether the TSM-Ai component is bypassed or engaged
